

## **Snowball Review Activity**

This is a fun review activity that works as well with adults as it does with children. It can be used to review a story or a set of stories.

### **Benefits of Snowball Review**

- Provides a safe, fun environment to recall facts
- Gets everyone up, moving, and laughing
- Corrects misinformation
- Builds relationships

### **Directions for Snowball Review**

1. Give every participant an identical blank piece of paper.
2. Each person should now write one interesting fact learned during a lesson or a unit of study.
3. Everyone now crumples up the paper with the answer on it.
4. Gather everyone in a large circle.
5. On the count of three, everyone is to GENTLY toss their snowball into the center of the circle.
6. Everyone now picks up a snowball from the center of the circle.
7. Go around the circle with each person reading the snowball they selected.
8. If possible, have one person enter the information into a word processing program to be projected onto a large screen.
9. Ask, "Is this statement correct?" Participants can now accept or politely correct the statement. The person who wrote the statement should be anonymous since names are not required on the snowball.
10. At the end, the list of ideas can be categorized. Possible categories: people, places, events, etc.
11. Print and give everyone a copy.
