Ten Commandments - Exodus 19 & 20

Watch the video Ten Commandments.

Turn each commandment into questions that God might ask. Assign one or two commandments to small groups. Try to develop questions that challenge someone to think about how they are living out the commandments or ignoring and disobeying the commandments. See some samples below.

Commandment	Commandment Expressed as Questions
You shall have no other God before me.	Do you look forward to spending time with me in prayer? What takes priority over Me: money, work, power, hobbies? Do you know and use any of my names?
You shall not make for yourself an idol (Ex 20:4)	Do you spend more time playing video games than praising me? What leads you into sin? Does your work or hobbies consume your time and take you away from prayer? Are you a people pleaser?
You shall not make wrongful use of the name of the Lord your God (Ex 20:7)	
Remember the Sabbath day, and keep it holy. (Ex 20:8)	
Honor your father and your mother, so that your days may be long in the land that the Lord your God is giving you. (Ex 20:12)	

You shall not murder. (Ex 20:13)	
You shall not commit adultery. (Ex 20:14)	
You shall not steal (Ex 20:15)	
You shall not bear false witness against your neighbor. (Ex 20:16)	
You shall not cover your neighbor's house; you shall not covet your neighbor's wife, or male or female slave, or ox, or donkey, or anything that belongs to your neighbor. (Ex 20:17)
